



## PRAYER MINISTRY of Montgomery Community Church

### **Question 1: How do I submit a praise/request?**

**Answer:** Click on the “share your praise/request” button, complete the drop-down form, and click the “submit prayer” button. (NOTE: The personal information you submit will be protected and kept confidential by an MCC staff member at all times. No one else will view or receive the personal information that you submit.)

### **Question 2: Why doesn't my praise or request show up immediately once I've submitted it?**

**Answer:** When a praise/request is submitted, it is then reviewed and edited if necessary by an MCC staff member. Once it is reviewed it will be posted onto our Prayer Wall.

### **Question 3: What does “Please...Share This” mean?**

**Answer:** It means you are giving us permission to publish your name and your praise/request on our Prayer Wall.

### **Question 4: What does “Please...Share This Anonymously” mean?**

**Answer:** It means you are giving us permission to publish your praise/request, but we WILL not post your name on the Prayer Wall. Instead it will say, “Anonymous” in that space.

### **Question 5: What does “Please Do Not Share This” mean?**

**Answer:** It means you are requesting that your praise/request be kept confidential and it will not be published or posted on our Prayer Wall. Each confidential request will ONLY be shared with MCC's pastoral staff.

### **Question 6: What does “Email When Someone Prays for Me” mean?**

**Answer:** If you put a check mark in the box next to that phrase, once your praise/request is reviewed and published on our Prayer Wall, others will be able to view it. If a person clicks the button located next to your praise/request which says, “I prayed for this,” an email will automatically generate and be sent to you stating, “Someone just prayed for you.” (Note: You will not be told the name of the person who clicked the button and prayed for you.)

**Question 7: What does “Share This on Twitter” mean?**

**Answer:** If you put a check mark in the box next to that phrase, your request will automatically be posted on MCC’s Twitter page.

**Question 8: Why do you not publish last names on the Prayer Wall?**

**Answer:** We have made the decision not to publish people’s last names so that we can protect their privacy and ensure their anonymity and confidentiality.

**Question 9: Can I remove or update a praise/prayer request?**

**Answer:** Once you submit your praise/request, an email will be sent to you. In the email you will find a link that allows you to remove your praise/request from our prayer wall (once the submitted praise/request is reviewed by our staff and published on the prayer wall). (NOTE: This action cannot be reversed). Unfortunately, once a praise/request is published, it cannot be updated. However, you can submit a new praise/request with the updated information.
